Airports	VC Bird International Airport Code: ANU T. 462-0358
Flight Information	Direct flights from UK
Entry Requirements:	British Nationals do not require a visa – a British passport with at least six months validity is required for entry. A stay of one month is granted upon entry stays in excess of one month will require an extension
Capital	St John's
Telephone	Island Code – 268 followed by the in-island seven digit number
Time Zone	Atlantic Standard Time – Four hours behind UK in winter, five hours behind in Summer
Health Requirements	The private medical clinic, Adelin, will not accept medical travel insurance in payment for treatment. Patients must pay a deposit (US\$4,000 in August 2005) via a credit card before treatment will be given. If funds deposited exceed the cost of the treatment, a refund will be given. You should check if your insurance company is willing to cover the cost of treatment at Adelin. If not, you will need to use the General Hospital. You should check any exclusions, and that your policy covers you for the activities you want to undertake Hepatitis A vaccination is recommended Please contact your health advisor for further current and specific advice
Transport Options	Local extensive bus network available as is taxi and car hire. Driving is on the left.
Safety	Sensible precautions should be taken -. Avoid isolated areas, including beaches after dark. Do not carry large amounts of cash or jewellery. Valuables and travel documents should be kept/stored safely
Electricity	110/220 volts/ 50 cycles–American two pin sockets used–an adaptor will be needed for uk appliances
Laws & Customs	Camouflage materials will not be allowed into the country. It is an offence for anyone (including children) to dress in camouflage clothing. Certain homosexual acts are illegal. Topless /nude bathing is frowned upon – there is a nudist beach at Hawksbill Bay
