### WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW

<b>Airports</b>	ET Joshua Airport, Kingstown, St Vincent Domestic airports on Bequia, Mustique, Canouan, Palm Island and Union Island
<b>Flight Information</b>	Flights via, Grenada, Barbados or St Lucia
<b>Entry Requirements:</b>	British Nationals do not require a visa for stays of up to three months.
<b>Capital</b>	Kingstown
<b>Telephone</b>	Island Code – 784 followed by the in-island seven digit number
<b>Time Zone</b>	Atlantic Standard Time – Four hours behind UK in winter, five hours behind in Summer
<b>Health Requirements</b>	It is recommended that medical insurance includes cover for air ambulance costs – complex medical cases are often referred overseas Hepatitis A vaccination is recommended Please contact your health advisor for further current and specific advice
<b>Transport Options</b>	Taxis are available with rates set by the government although you should clarify the fare before commencing your journey. . Car hire is available driving is on the left. You will need to bring your full driving licence and purchase a permit for US\$50. International Driver's Licences need stamping at the local police station
<b>Safety</b>	Sensible precautions should be taken -. Avoid isolated areas, including beaches after dark. Do not carry large amounts of cash or jewellery. Valuables and travel documents should be kept/stored safely
<b>Electricity</b>	220/240- volts/ 50 cycles– Square three rectangular pin sockets used–an adaptor will be needed for uk appliances Petit St Vincent – 110 volts 60 cycle
<b>Laws &amp; Customs</b>	Camouflage materials will not be allowed into the country. It is an offence for anyone (including children) to dress in camouflage clothing. Certain homosexual acts are illegal. Keep prescription medication in original packaging for clear identification and carry in your hand luggage. Importation of fresh beef from the UK is not permitted
